Above listed subject was identified by a witness after a press release was disseminated for the incident. The independent witness was very familiar with the subject as she knows him from working in the area (downtown Oakland) and has had several interactions with him.

The press release incident in which she identified him for was from 31 Jan 21 who pushed three elderly citizens in the 800 block of Harrison. The first citizen was 91 years old and suffered lacerations, abrasions and a contusion to the left thumb. The second and third were a couple in which the female half lost consciousness due to the fall and suffered a deep laceration to her chin requiring stitches. Muslim was placed on a psychiatric hold the following day (2/1/21) for a separate incident in which he was again assaulting people in the 900 block of Harrison St. He was transported to Santa Rita today from JGP.
